15. MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS : 40.
16. MAXIMUM ENTRIES PER VEHICLE: 4.  
(more may be allowed at the discretion of the Director / Officer)
17. STARTING TIME : Event entry opens at 8.30am at the venue. Event Start 10.00am. Sharp, and concludes at 3.30pm.
18. DRIVERS' BRIEFING: 9.45am at the venue.
19. SCRUTINEERING: 8.30am till 9.30am at the venue.
20. SCRUTINEERING SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS: All drivers shall wear a CAMS approved crash helmet whilst competing. All vehicles shall be fitted with a fire extinguisher to NCR's. Where no windscreen is

fitted, drivers must wear eye protection in accordance with the NCR's. CAMS approved helmets (including eye protection) must be worn by ALL persons in specials.

21. CLASSES :

- A 0 - 1300 cc
- B 1301 - 1600 cc
- C 1601 - 2000 cc
- D 2001 and over
- E 4H Vehicles (Motorkhana Specials)
- F 4 Wheel Drive Production Cars (Non-production 4WD or 4WS vehicles are NOT permitted)
- L Ladies
- JN Junior (from 14 to under 16 years of age)
- JR Junior (from 17 to under 18 years of age)

22. PRIZES AND TROPHIES: Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd outright and depending on the number of entries may be awarded to class winners. Where there are less than 3 entrants per class, the Director may elect not to award a trophy for that class. Where a class winner is awarded an outright place award, the next entrant in that class will be awarded the class award.  
Presentation of all trophies will be conducted at the clubs annual end of year presentation night. Competitors will receive an invitation to the presentation night. Awards that have not been collected will be mailed to the competitor address taken from their entry form.
23. The C.A.M.S Permit will be displayed at the start of the event.
24. The organisers may refuse any entry without assigning a reason.
25. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.
26. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent / guardian.
27. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS Licence or superior (2NS is the minimum requirement) as specified in Appendix I of the 2005 CAMS Manual.
28. Public Risk Insurance has been affected by the organisers.
29. The organisers may cancel, alter, abandon or postpone the event without assigning a reason.
30. Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with the NCR's.
31. NO ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR or PROHIBITED DRUGS may be consumed in the pit, paddock, course or control areas during the competition. A breach of this regulation invites imposition of severe penalties.
32. Special Requirement :
- a) LICENCES: Drivers will require to have at the event, and MUST present to event officials, a current CAMS Level 2NS Licence (or higher) and a current CAMS affiliated club membership.
  - b) PASSENGERS: No passengers may be carried in a vehicle while competing, as per paragraph 8.2 (i) of the Khanacross Regulations in the CAMS manual.  
Any offending driver will be excluded from further participation in the event  
  
**Note:** Juniors may carry a passenger as an instructor, subject to prior approval by the Director of the event, as per paragraph 8.2 (ii) of the Khanacross Regulations in the CAMS manual. The vehicle must be fitted with an appropriate seat and seatbelt, with the passenger seated in the seat and the seatbelt worn correctly. This person must also wear a C.A.M.S. approved crash helmet, as per section 19, of these regulations.
  - c) RESULTS : Preliminary results will be handed to all competitors on the day, after conclusion of the event. Final results will be mailed, or e-mailed to each competitor. Competitor address or e-mail address will be taken from their entry form.
  - d) BARBEQUE LUNCH AND REFRESHMENTS will be on sale at the venue. Please place your lunch order with the Secretary when submitting your entry form. Drinks are available all day.
  - e) Toilet & Shower facilities only are available at these grounds.
