Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Cars must be adequately muffled. Competitors must produce a valid and current CAMS Competition Licence and Club Membership Card of a CAMS-Affiliated Car Club and Log Book (if issued) at document check. Current and valid CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Competition Licence

Production 4WD ATV vehicles must be fitted with a Driver's side window net.

Khanacross Competition: 1st, 2nd, 3rd Outright,
1st in each Class (minimum of 3 class entries required)
1st Junior & 1st Lady

Results shall be determined by the lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, inclusive of penalties. Timing shall be to 0.01 Second.

24. The CAMS Permit will be displayed at the start of the Event.
25. The Organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.
26. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.
27. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to Parent/Guardian.
28. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.
29. Event Organizers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.
30. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.
31. Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
32. Fuel and water is not available at the venue, Toronto is 5 minutes' drive north. Hot Food and Cold and Hot drinks will be available.
33. Competition numbers shall be allocated at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.
